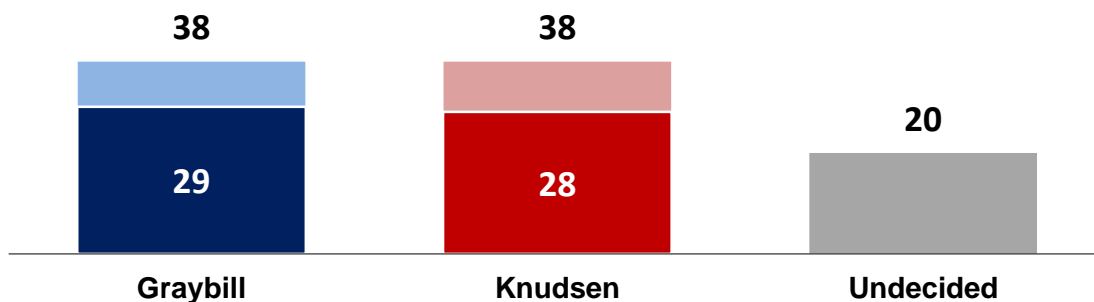

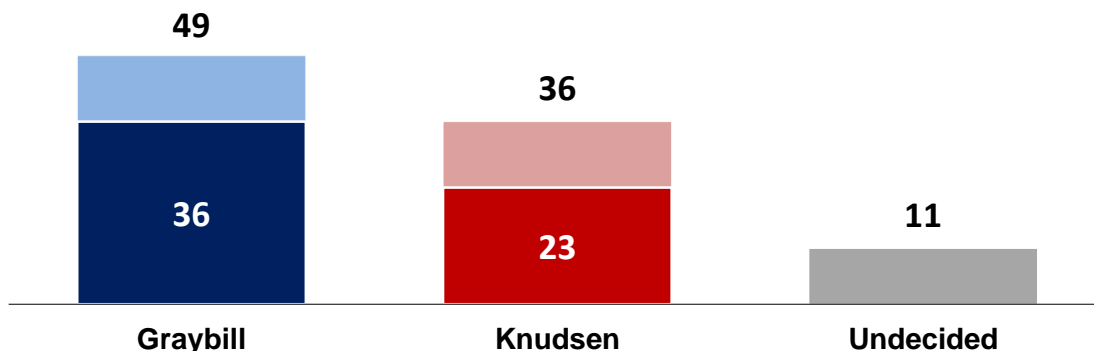
Our new survey of likely general election voters¹ in Montana shows Democrat Raph Graybill dead even with Republican Austin Knudsen in the race for Montana’s open Attorney General seat (Graybill 38%; Knudsen 38%). Graybill is significantly overperforming in a state with a 7-point Republican partisan advantage (36% Democrat, 43% Republican, 14% independent).

Montana Attorney General – Initial Ballot



At the conclusion of the survey after additional positive and comparative messaging, Graybill leads Knudsen 49% to 36%, with Graybill up by +13 points up on the final ballot. With enough resources to communicate his message, Raph Graybill is in a strong position to compete and win in this competitive race.

¹ Lake Research Partners conducted a live telephone survey among 500 likely November 2020 general election voters in Montana. The survey was conducted August 20-26, 2020 and has a margin of error of +/-4.4%. Darker colors in the graphs reflect strong support.
